What should I write about?

Your best/worst memory, something embarrassing that happened, something that changed your life, something that stands out to you as a representative example of your youth or adulthood in Tuscarawas County. The stories must adhere to only two rules: they must be true, and they must not harm anyone in the telling. See the reverse side for some prompt questions to help you get started. How can I win \$200?

The editing team at Dover Public Library will award the prize of \$200.00 to the most appealing story. We will also offer two runner up awards of \$50.00. Writing ability is NOT a factor. There is no cost to submit a story, and you are under no obligation.

When can I get the book?

Tapestries of Tuscarawas County will be released in the fall of 2016. Contributors will be able to purchase a copy at a discounted price. It will also be available at Dover Public Library and other local libraries and historical societies. Write your letter today! - Maximum length: 3,000 words
- Include only one story with each submission form. You may make copies of the form and send us more than one story.
- You accept full responsibility for what you write and assure us it is not copyrighted. You give us permission to edit and publish your letter in any of our publications, to shorten it if necessary, and to assign a title. We will mail your edited material to you to check for errors before it appears in the book.
- You are not required to purchase a book or pay to win an award or to have your story published. If your story is published, you will be able to purchase a copy of the book at a discounted price.
- We reserve the right to reject any material at any time. The written material you send can't be returned, so be sure to keep a copy.

- What was the happiest moment of your life? The saddest?
- If you could hold on to one memory from your life forever, what would that be?
- Do you have any favorite stories about your kids?
- Do you have any favorite stories from your childhood?
- What are your best memories of grade school/high school/college/graduate school? Worst memories?
- Do you have any favorite stories from school?
- Do you have any favorite stories from your work life?
- Do you have any favorite stories from your marriage or about your husband/wife?
- Have you experienced any miracles?
- What was the most profound spiritual moment of your life?
- What traditions have been passed down in your family?
- What are your classic family stories? Jokes? Songs?
