Pie in the Library: A Pie Contest Saturday, August 5 at 1:00 PM

Contest Rules

- 1. Pie must be entered in the name of the person who made it.
- 2. This contest is intended for Adult (18 years and older) amateur bakers only. Professional bakers or those who earn a portion of their livelihood from baking or cooking may not enter the contest.
- 3. Each dessert pie must be made from scratch and based in a 9" pie plate/pan.
- 4. Each pie must include a serving utensil and a cover.
- 5. You may not use pie filling or a pre-made store-bought crust.
- 6. Categories
 - Apple
 - o Fruit & Berry
 - Nutty
 - Sweet

7. To Enter Your Pie

- a. Bring your pie to the library between 11:00 AM and 12:30 PM on Saturday, August 5. The staff running the Pie Contest will have the final say on acceptability of pies.
- b. Pies must be in an appropriate covered container until judging.
- c. The Health Department says: **NO PIES THAT REQUIRE REFRIGERATION** (i.e. dairy or cream pies).
- d. Only one entry per person per category.
- e. Fill out the registration form.

If you are a winner, you give your permission to have your photo taken during the announcement ceremony and have it used for Pie Contest promotional materials, including social media & the library website.

8. Judging

- a. Between 1:00-1:30 PM
- b. There will be a minimum of three judges.
- c. Criteria
 - i. Overall appearance

- ii. Crust color, texture, doneness and flavor
- iii. Filling consistency, doneness and flavor
- iv. Overall taste
- d. Scoring
 - i. Each judge assigns a numerical value (1-5) in each criteria category, without consultation with the other judges.
 - ii. The pie receiving the highest total numerical value is the winner in that category.
 - iii. In the case of a tie, the judges will judge those pies again.
- e. The decision of the judges is final. Judges will not know contestant names.
- 9. Winners will be announced after judging.
- 10. Participants must be present during contest and judging.
- 11. Following the judging, all pies will be available for the community to enjoy. Pies will be eaten that day.
