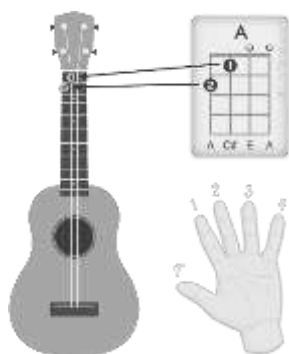

How to Hold

Neck points 10 o'clock on your body. Left hand holds neck and takes care of chords. Right hand strums above the sound hole.

How to Strum

Point at yourself, point at the ground; repeat
Starting slower, make sure you strum all of the strings
Speed up, strumming all strings as you go
Strum on the beat the way you would tap your foot, throwing in an up strum every now and then



How to Read a Chord Chart

1 is your index finger
2 is your middle finger
3 is your ring finger
4 is your pinky (rarely used)

The Boxes refer to the Fret
The Lines refer to the Strings
