

After rescuing a girl who was trapped in cryo-sleep for two centuries from interdimensional space, eighteen-year-old Aurora Academy graduate Tyler Jones is swept up in an interstellar war millions of years in the making. Recommended for ages 14+ on Common Sense Media.

3) Gumdrop Angel (Five Nights at Freddy's: Fazbear Frights #8) by Scott Cawthorn

Five Nights at Freddy's fans won't want to miss this pulse-pounding collection of three novellalength tales that will keep even the bravest FNAF player up at night. Recommended for ages 12+ by publisher.

4) Concrete Rose by Angie Thomas

International phenomenon Angie Thomas revisits Garden Heights seventeen years before the events of *The Hate U Give* in this searing and poignant exploration of Black boyhood and manhood. Recommended for ages 14+ by publisher.
